LAKE CRAIG FLOOD MANAGEMENT-AZALEA ROAD PROJECT

Project Information: In an effort to reduce downstream flooding impacts, the project has evaluated Lake Craig Dam at Azalea Park along with upstream flood plain fill removal for flood mitigation. The project also includes river restoration along the Swannanoa River, a much needed water line extension to John B. Lewis Soccer Complex, and roadway improvements along Azalea Road. This is the third and final of three (3) community meetings to present information about the project designs and the draft Environmental Assessment document.

Public Meeting Purpose: The consultant team will be available to meet with the community, present the current project preferred designs and draft Environment Assessment document as well as discuss the overall timeline. This meeting is free to the public and will be held in an open-house/flexible drop-in format.
