



Closure of Cherry Street parking lot for repairs

On Monday January 31, 2011 the gravel parking lot on Cherry Street between Flint Street and Cumberland Avenue will be closed for repairs. The lot will be resurfaced with crushed stone and a cable fence will be installed around the lot area to prevent vehicles from extending out into Cherry Street.
